## Changes

- A **\$15 administration fee** will be charged to transfers/changes.
- All requests for week changes after registration will be granted provided there is space available.
- Request for session changes must be received six or more working days prior to the start date.

## Absenteeism

If your child is unable to attend camp, please inform us as soon as possible by calling the Rady JCC Membership Desk at 204-477-7510.

## Refunds

- **Refunds, minus a 20% administration fee** per registration, will be given up to seven or more working days prior to camp session commencement.
- There is no reduction or refunds of fees due to absence or illness, once camp has begun.
- No refunds will be issued when a child is asked to leave camp.
- In order to receive a refund, please submit your original receipt.
- The Rady JCC reserves the right to cancel camp session(s) in the case of insufficient registration in which case a full refund would be given.

## Camper Information Forms

The Rady JCC and the Manitoba Camping Association require that camper information forms are completed in full and submitted to the Rady JCC no later than the two weeks prior to the start of each camp session to ensure information is current, or your child will be unable to attend camp. If information changes, it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to let us know so we can update camp records.

## Staff

All Rady JCC Summer Day Camp staff is chosen by their experience, ability to relate to children and leadership skills. Staff receives training which includes program development, CPR & First Aid Certification, water safety, and inclusion training. All staff is screened through the Child Abuse Registry and Criminal Records Search to ensure the safety of all campers.

## Food Allergies

Please understand that although supervision is provided, there will be no structured activities during this time. **Please note: There is a late fee for pick-up after 5:00 pm.**

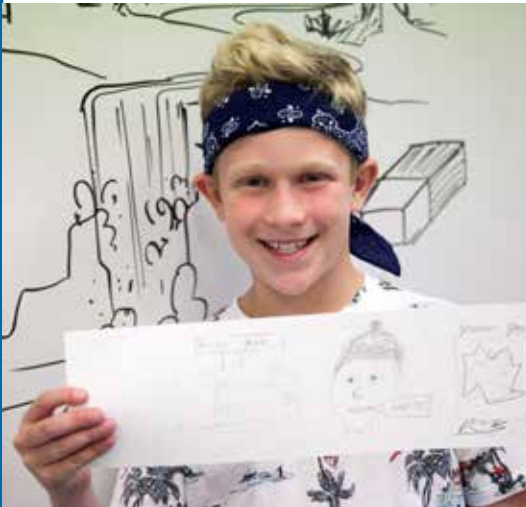
