



Dear Day Camp Families,

Welcome to the Rady JCC Summer Day Camps! Your child is in for a great camp experience with fun and exciting activities.

To ensure a safe and comfortable environment for all participants, we would like to take this opportunity to make you aware of certain guidelines we are putting in place for this summer.

Camp Times

Due to COVID restrictions camp will run from 8:15-4:15 pm every day. There will be no pre or post camp care in 2020.

- Drop off will take place between 8:15 am -9:00 am.
- Pick-Up will take place between 3:45 pm -4:15 pm.
- Please expect a delay at drop off if you come past 9:00 am.

Shemesh Drop-Off & Pick-Up

Drop off

Drop off will run from 8:15am-9:00 am.

- When dropping your child off, please use the parking loop at the front of the Asper Campus off Doncaster Street.
- Please park in the designated Shemesh parking stalls indicated on the parking map found below. There will be Rady Camp Staff to help with parking
- The door to enter the building is located next to the play structure and will be marked with large Rady JCC Day Camp flags.
- Every person that enters the building will be required to sanitize upon entrance.
- You will need to check in with the security team upon arrival and identify yourself as a summer day camp family.
- Once you have checked in, you will be granted access to the designated drop off area.
- During drop off we will conduct daily wellness checks that will include temperature scans and health screening questions. If a camper has a temperature that is above 100.4 degrees F, you will be required to take your camper home and they will only be able to return to camp once they have been cleared by a doctor. Staff members administering the screening process will be required to wear masks to ensure everyone's safety in the process.
- During drop-off you will be asked to provide the name of the person picking up your camper that day to ensure an effective and safe pick-up procedure.

Pick- Up

Pick-Up will run from 3:45 pm -4:15 pm.

- Pick-up will take place in the Shemesh rooms, located in the Gray Academy Elementary school. Please be prepared to show your ID when picking-up your camper.
- If you are designating someone else to pick up your child, please ensure that you have advised the Camp office and that they arrive with photo identification.

NEW: Ruach and Keshet Curbside Drop Off & Pick-Up:

This year the Day Camp will be doing strictly curbside drop-off and pick-up for campers in the Ruach and Keshet Camps. Due to COVID-19 we are limiting the adults in the building to camp counselors and instructors.

Parents/Guardians will not be permitted on site due to these restrictions. If you need to drop-off or pick-off your child at an alternate time, please alert the camp office in advance so proper arrangements can be made.

Drop-Off

- Drop off will run from 8:15 am - 9:00am.
- Camp programming will begin at 9:00 am sharp.
- Please expect a delay at drop off if you come past 9:00 am.

When dropping your child off, please use the Simkin parking loop at the front of the Asper Campus off Doncaster Street. We will be running strictly curb side drop-off and pick-up for campers in the Ruach and Keshet Camps.

Attached to this email is a **Day Camp Drop-Off Pass** that will indicate which camp you are dropping off for and the zone where you will be pulling up for drop-off and pick-up. Please ensure that your drop-off pass is visible on your dashboard when dropping off your camper.

There will be specific zones for each Keshet camp (i.e. Kids in the Kitchen, Sportsmania, etc.). Ruach will have 1 zone for Drop-Off. Please consult the parking map found below to familiarize yourself with the different drop-off zones.

- Upon pulling up to your drop off zone, you, as well as your camper(s) should remain in the vehicle.
- One of our staff will approach your car to screen the camper before the camper exits the car and is then taken to their specific group.
- We will conduct daily wellness checks that will include temperature scans and health screening questions. If a camper has a temperature that is above 100.4 degrees F, you will be required to take your camper home and they will only be able to return to camp once they have been cleared by a doctor. Staff members administrating the screening process will be required to wear masks to ensure everyone's safety in the process.
- The screening process will be straight forward and quick but expect to be here for a few minutes upon both drop- off and pick up. Please plan accordingly regarding the rest of your day.
- During Drop-Off you will be asked to provide us with the name of the person(s) picking up your camper from camp that day. If you do not know who will be picking up, **it is the parent/guardians' responsibility to notify us by email/ phone prior to pick up that day, no later than 2:00 pm.**
- Failure to notify the camp of the authorized pick-up for that day will result in a phone call to the emergency contact upon pick-up to verify the identity of the person(s) picking-up your camper.
- In addition to notifying us about the authorized pick-up for your camper, you will be requested to specify whether you will be picking up your camper during **the first round of pick-ups, taking place from 3:45 pm to 4:00, or the second round of pick- ups, taking place from 4:00-4:15.**

Pick up

- Campers will be brought outside in shifts in accordance with the parent/ guardian(s) indicated pick-up time preference (3:45-4:00pm or 4:00-4:15pm).
- When picking your child up, please use the parking loop at the front of the Asper Campus. Upon picking up your child from camp, please head to your designated pick-up zone (the same as where you dropped-off in the AM), remain in your vehicle, and a staff member will bring your camper to the car. Please be prepared to show your ID upon picking-up your camper.

Drop-off and pick-up will take place in the Simkin Loop. The entrance to the loop is located off Doncaster Street. Please be mindful of children crossing the road in the parking lot at both drop-off and pick-up times

Rady Summer Days Camps 2020 Safety Measures

The health and safety of everyone in our camp community is always our highest priority. We are planning responsibly for the upcoming summer season. The 2020 season will be different from summers past, but we are sure that it will stay a fun, and engaging summer. Below are the safety measures that we are implementing for the 2020 camp season.

- Daily Health Screening Checks including temperature checks for campers and staff
- Curbside Drop-Off & Pick-Up times utilizing different building entrances
- Maximum of 16-20 campers for the majority of camp groups
- No-contact camps to be offered such as Floor Hockey, Soccer
- No camp-wide activities; programming to be staggered and spread out accordingly
- Swimming to be limited to 16-20 children at a time
- PPE for camp staff
- No Hot Lunch Program to be offered
- Toys, Equipment and Often-Touched surfaces will be sanitized regularly
- Campers to wash hands/sanitize between activities
- We are working with the Asper Campus to ensure the sufficient cleaning of washroom, railings etc.
- Physical Distancing Measures
- Sanitization Protocols

COVID-19 Procedures:

Our focus at Day Camp, in addition to implementing physical distancing as best we can, will be on screening and disinfection. Group sizes have been reduced to implement more effective physical distancing throughout the day at camp.

Our goal will be to provide campers with a safe, fun, and active week of activities! We have modified our daily routine and procedures to allow for more transition and physical space for each group. Our Rady JCC Day Camp standards are substantially above what was outlined by the Provincial Government regarding both space and group sizes.

Sanitization Protocols:

Campers will be required to sanitize upon entering the building and will be required to thoroughly wash their hands throughout the day. Campers will be reminded to sanitize on all major transitions throughout the building. Prior to camp opening, the Health Officers gave a glowing report on how many sanitization stations and procedures the Rady JCC has in place.

Prior to sending your child to camp, please have a discussion with them regarding proper hand washing procedures. Hand washing/ sanitization will be required before and after meals, after you cough or sneeze, as well as before and after using any equipment/ toys. Please also remind your campers to cough and sneeze into their elbow to avoid the spread of germs as best we can! Below are some visuals that you can show your camper to help with this.

Rooms, as well as toys, equipment, and the play structure, will all be sanitized before and after a group has used them. Additionally, there will be a thorough cleaning of the facility every evening post camp.

The staff and administrative team have gone through proper sanitation protocol training and are well prepared to ensure that we maintain a clean facility.

What No to Bring to Camp:

- * Electronics

Food Allergies:

Due to life threatening allergies, please do not send snacks or lunches containing **NUTS** (including Nutella, almond butter, and peanut butter), or **FISH** (including shellfish).

Medical Forms:

Please ensure that you have filled out a medical form for your child. If not, please do so and email it to daycamp@radyjcc.com before your camper's first day of camp.

Aquatics:

- * Please pack a bathing suit and towel daily for swimming and outdoor water activities. Children may be doing outdoor water activities and they will have to walk outside to get there. Therefore, please pack flip flops or sandals for your children every day.
- * Children between the ages of 3 and 5 (Shemesh) must always wear a lifejacket and are not permitted to go deeper than the black line in the shallow end.
- * Children aged 6 and 7 (Ruach) must always wear a lifejacket and may use the entire shallow end; however, they are not permitted in the deep end.
- * If your child has passed Crocodile or Level 1, they may bring their report card and show it to the lifeguards. This will allow them to go in the pool without a lifejacket.
- * Children who are 8 years old and over may swim in the deep end at the discretion of the lifeguard. They must swim 25 meters of Level 6 front crawl before being allowed to use the deep end.
- * Please note that these rules are implemented by the Rady JCC and not the Day Camp. Should you have any further questions regarding the pool, please contact our Aquatics Supervisor at (204)-477-7541.

Ruach Friend Requests:

If your camper is attending the Ruach camp (entering grades 1 & 2) please ensure you fill out the friend request survey found at the link bellow. Friend requests are capped at a maximum of 2 requests.

Please complete the survey no later than **the Thursday prior to your week of camp by 9:00 am**. We will not be able to accommodate any friend requests after the cut-off day and we will not be able to switch campers between groups as we are required to limit group sizes and are trying our best to limit exposure between campers.

Friend requests are only for the Ruach Camp. The Keshet Camp groups are pre-established by the specialty camp you registered your camper for and Shemesh will run as one group.

Emergency Procedures and Medical Care

- * In case of an accident or injury at camp, the Camp will first attempt to contact the child's parent(s)/guardian. If this is not possible, the additional listed emergency contacts will be notified.
- * Please ensure that the emergency contacts are aware that they are being used as such to avoid any confusion in the case of an emergency.
- * The camp has an onsite, full-time medical health officer on staff for immediate care.
